What data do we collect?

Our Company collects the following data:

- * Personal identification information (Name, email address)
- * License plate numbers / Car identifiers

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Our Company with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- * Register online or place an order for any of our products or services.
- * You request an admin to create an account for you.
- * Voluntarily provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- * Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.
- * Use our Android application.

How will we use your data?

Our Company collects your data so that we can:

- * Manage your account.
- * Provide you with analytics based on the data

How do we store your data?

Our Company securely stores your data at our web server and accompanying backups. Our backups are hosted in Stockholm and our web server is hosted in Finland. The backups are accessible only with 2FA authentication or from our servers with password protected SHA keys.

Our Company will keep your personal information (name and email) until the account is deleted or until the company to which the account is associated to, stops using the service. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by removing it from our database. The data will be preserved in database backups for 180 days and after that deleted.

Our Company will keep your license plate numbers or car identifiers until the company to which the license plate number is associated with stops using the service. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by removing the license plate numbers from all systems and databases associated with the company.

What are your data protection rights?

Our Company would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Our Company for copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Our Company correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Our Company to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Our Company erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Our Company restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Our Company's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Our Company transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you. If you would like to
